Role Summary

The Asset Management Team carries out responsive repairs and planned installations to its housing stock.

This role is to carry out internal mould treatments and painting to the Group's properties. These could be to tenanted or void properties. You will evidence work required and undertaken by taking photographs at each stage.

You will provide an excellent level of customer service whilst working to the highest standards of efficiency, safety and customer satisfaction.

MAIN TASKS OR ACTIVITIES

1. Carry out internal mould treatments and painting to the Group's property using specialist mould treatment products in line with manufacturer's instructions.
2. Using a PDA system collate evidence including taking photographs before and after works.
3. Report items of joinery, metalwork, plaster and damaged surfaces which require replacement or repairing prior to mould treatment or painting to the planners.
4. Pre-Inspect properties and assess specification and quantity of materials required to ensure quality of finished job and quality of service to customer, making sure surfaces are covered with cloth or plastic to ensure protection during the treatment process.
5. Advise the Operations Manager of any work which cannot be completed during that visit. Promptly complete records of work completed or delayed due to no access or any other reason.
6. Help and work with residents regarding property issues, arranging appointments with the planners as and when required.
7. Clean up work areas after completion of jobs.
8. Carry out all duties in accordance with Health and Safety requirements.
9. Follow all Group policies and procedures in accordance with the role and attend mandatory training when requested to ensure compliance with the Group policies and procedures.
10. Ensure you work in accordance with the Equality Act 2010 and the Equality, Diversity & Inclusion Policy at all times.

11. Carry out any duty which may be, from time to time, requested by the Chief Executive, Deputy Chief Executive or Group Directors, commensurate with the position.
