### Role Summary

We are looking for a highly skilled and motivated Senior Microsoft 365 Developer to create, develop, and implement innovative digital solutions using the Microsoft Power Platform and the broader M365 ecosystem. This position is vital to our digital transformation goals, helping to provide smarter, more efficient services for staff and residents. Responsibilities include building model-driven and canvas apps, automating workflows, and integrating solutions across Microsoft 365 and Azure services.

Additionally, you will offer technical insights, mentor junior developers, and contribute to architectural decisions and standards. The role also involves exploring emerging technologies like Copilot Studio to improve user experience and productivity.

## MAIN TASKS OR ACTIVITIES

1. Design, develop, and implement scalable, secure, and user-centric applications using Power Apps (canvas and model-driven), Power Automate, and Dataverse.
2. Integrate Microsoft 365 services (e.g. SharePoint Online, Teams, OneDrive) and external systems using APIs, Microsoft Graph, and Azure Logic Apps.
3. Ensure all solutions are designed and implemented with appropriate security controls, including authentication, authorisation, and data protection measures.
4. Maintain comprehensive technical documentation, including solution architecture, user guides, and operational procedures.
5. Monitor application performance and availability using tools such as Azure Monitor, Application Insights, and Power Platform Admin Centre.
6. Implement and manage CI/CD pipelines, version control, and environment strategies using Azure DevOps or equivalent tools.
7. Ensure all solutions comply with security, accessibility, and data protection standards (e.g. GDPR, WCAG, Cyber Essentials Plus).
8. Collaborate with information governance and security teams to ensure compliance with data loss prevention (DLP) policies, sensitivity labels, and conditional access.
9. Mentor junior team members and citizen developers, promoting best practices in coding, testing, documentation, and DevOps.

10. Provide authoritative technical advice to stakeholders, translating business needs into effective digital solutions.
11. Champion the use of Microsoft 365 and Power Platform capabilities across the organisation, including emerging tools like Copilot Studio and AI integrations.
12. Collaborate with business analysts and service leads to identify opportunities for business process automation and improvement.
13. Contribute to the development of organisational policies, design patterns, and governance frameworks for low-code/no-code development.
14. Stay abreast of Microsoft roadmap developments and assess their applicability to organisational needs.
