## OVERVIEW

We are seeking an experienced and adaptable Building Surveyor to join our Planned Maintenance team.

The successful candidate will work with the Surveying Manager, with specific responsibilities for carrying out building inspections and surveys of both occupied and void properties. You will also work alongside the Healthy Homes Team, to help diagnose and rectify damp & mould issues.

With a sound technical background, you will be able to diagnose typical building defects, carry out stock condition surveys and monitor works carried out by both our in-house technicians and contractors.

You will have excellent customer service skills and be able to give clear advice and explanation of work that is needed or being carried out to our residents.

You will demonstrate current knowledge of all relevant legislation and Health & Safety regulations including CDM 2015 and Asbestos.

## MAIN TASKS OR ACTIVITIES

1. Undertake surveys/inspections on both occupied and void properties.
2. Determine maintenance requirements and produce schedules of work/ tender documents as necessary and obtain quotations.
3. Diagnose building defects as necessary and propose remedial action, particularly in respect of dampness and structural works.
4. Overall supervision, ordering and inspection of any repairs or improvements needed to our homes.
5. Inspect work during and on completion to check the quality of workmanship, completion times and value for money.
6. Inspect work where the tenant is dissatisfied with the completed repair.
7. Assess the performance of contractors and review their performance.
8. Carry out asbestos validation surveys and sampling (where qualified to do so) and Fire Risk Assessment review surveys
9. Carry out audits in accordance with the Fire Reform Order and order any necessary works
10. Supervise and manage Environmental Sustainability projects through possible grant funding as directed.
11. Inspect properties for insurance claims.
12. Identify any repairs that fall under the tenant's responsibility and give advice on the options available.
13. Identify major component replacements or major repairs via stock condition surveys

14. Take appropriate action to ensure that the service meets the Group's performance targets in all areas of Asset Management.
15. Follow all Group policies and procedures in accordance with the role and attend Mandatory training when requested to ensure compliance with Group policies and procedures.
16. Ensure you work in accordance with the Equality Act 2010 and the Equality, Diversity & Inclusion Policy at all times.
17. Carry out any duty which may be, from time to time, requested by the Chief Executive, Deputy Chief Executive or Group Directors commensurate with the position.
